The Construction Workforce Initiative 2 (CWI2) is the next generation of the public-private collaboration working together to create quality training and employment opportunities for Connecticut residents to be a part of the state's active construction industry. CWI2's strategy is to implement a program that provides specialized training opportunities to develop participants to be competitive in the job market. CWI2 sees a need for local participation in the technical aspects of the construction industry. Locally there is a shortage of technical training, especially within marginalized groups. CWI2 is prepared to create a source for trained individuals to join the industry through these specialized and specific careers through the Construction Management Enhanced Training (COMET) program, which is *FREE* of charge to all participants!

HOW WE TRAIN

CWI2's sequence of modules is designed to provide participants with knowledge beyond classroom experiences that will enable them to operate effectively in an assistant/intern position within the construction industry. The emphasis is on a full spectrum of subjects, pertinent to the operation proces of construction management. Trainees will complete a six month program, including the following courses:

- Construction Management Software
- Procore Certification
- Construction Estimating Tools
- Submittal Process Workshop

HOW TO APPLY

Visit us online at CWI2.com/COMET to fill out the application. This program is completely **FREE** of charge to all participants!

After completing the online application, each candidate will receive an email with further instructions, including the date for the Orientation session, and the required documents (transcripts, letter of recommendation, etc.) to submit.

REQUIREMENTS

- Participants must be 18 years or older
- Reliable Transportation (Driver's License or Learning Permit Preferred)
- High School Diploma or GED with Transcripts
 - C or better in Math Courses
- Ability to Pass a Drug Test
- Provide a Letter of Recommendation

OCCUPATIONS

The COMET program will prepare participants to launch a career in the following occupations.

• Construction Manager/Project Engineer Assistant

Ensure the job is constructed according to the project plans, and assist project controls, including budgeting, scheduling, and planning.

• Site Construction Superintendent Assistant

Schedules contractors, consultants and vendors while inspecting project quality

• Record Management/Documents Control Assistant

Manages company documents for accuracy and integrity

• Safety Manager Assistant

Establishes, supports and maintains on-site safety policies according to industry standards

Financial Controller Assistant

Maintains and keeps financial accounting and processes

There is a direct need for inclusion in these occupations throughout the New Haven County construction industry. After successful completion of the training, participants will have the opportunity to begin an internship with one of the many large scale construction contractors with excellent career opportunities. Assistants & interns in these occupations can potentially earn a starting salary of over \$35,000 per year with the possibility to continue on to positions that can earn over \$70,000 per year.
